

Terms and Conditions – Group registration

Jamboree26

Registrations for Jamboree26 is binding after the registration deadline.

The person who registers a group to participate at Jamboree26 ensure that they have the right to do so and that the group will pay the participant fee for all registered participants. If not, the person who made the registration is personally responsible for the payment of the group's total participation fee.

At least one person above the age of 18 must be present during the jamboree and take the full responsibility for the participating group.

The deadline for participant registration is February 15, 2026, and the participation fee will be invoiced in February/March with a 30 day payment period. After the registration deadline, additional participants may be allowed to register with an additional participation fee of 250 SEK if The Guides and Scouts of Sweden deem it possible.

The group is obliged to pay the full fee that applies to all registered participants, except in the following cases:

1. Participants who unsubscribe before the registration deadline will be deleted from the lists and no payment will have to be made.
2. A participant can be exchanged for another individual from the same group until the start of the camp. The Guides and Scouts of Sweden must be informed when this happens. There is no additional fee. The Jamboree organisers cannot guarantee all forms of accessibility adjustment if changes are made close to the start of the Jamboree
3. If a person cannot participate due to their own illness, that was not known at the time of registration, and can be supported by a medical certificate, the fee will be refunded without deduction.
4. If a person cannot participate due to a close relative's illness or death, the fee will be refunded without deduction.
5. If the jamboree management team before or during the camp deems a participant unable to participate in the event in a safe and secure manner, the jamboree management team may deny this person the right to participate. If so, the fee will be refunded without deduction.

In case of cancellations for any reason other than the ones above, no refund will be made. If the full participation fee has not been paid by the time of cancellation, the group is obligated to pay the remaining amount.

No refund will be given for participants who have started their participation in Jamboree26, regardless of the reason.

If, against all odds, Jamboree26 were to receive more registrations than the campsite can accommodate there will be a limit of a maximum of 10% international participants. The allocation of international participants will be on a first come first served basis.

In the event that The Guides and Scouts of Sweden decides to cancel or postpone Jamboree26, participation fees already paid will be refunded after deductions for those project costs that The Guides and Scouts of Sweden, at the time of the decision, has already paid or is contractually committed to without the possibility of reimbursement.

Insurance
