What is Jamboree26?

- National jamboree of the Guides and Scouts of Sweden
- Norra Åsum ("Northern Awesome"), Kristianstad, Skåne, Sweden
- Just over 18 000 people on site
 - Approx 1 500 staff (370 IST)





Swedish scouts and international guests will experience a large and vibrant scout camp where we meet, build bridges and tie friendship knots.

Together, we overcome challenges and grow through adventure, both as individuals and as a group.

Being IST

- A bit like an ordinary job
- Only a lot more fun!

- Scheduling depends on the job
- Patrol leader who knows what to do

- Instructions on site



IST– There are some different kinds

1. Camp staff

- During the staff period July 22 - August 3
 - Live in the staff camp
 - Or with your group between (July 25 and August 1) if they are there and have room...
- Eat in the staff dining area – Himmel (Heaven)

2. *Leader staff (only Swedish)*

- *Work as staff July 25 - August 1*
- *Arrive and leave with your group*
- *Sleep and eat with your group.
Work schedules are adjusted for this*

3. Pre camp and post camp

- This is the construction and deconstruction of the camp site. We will build tents and portals, install furniture, put up signs and everything else
- Sleep and live in the staff camp

About your Camp period and maybe Pre-camp?

- No participant fee
- Review and update dates in your application!
- We really need to know when you're available to work.
- Include full days you'll be off,
- which day you'll arrive,
- and when you'll leave.
- This is extremely important so that we can plan the camp properly!



Expectations

On you, on us, on each other.

Jamboree26 – we'll do it together!

Come as you are and give what you can.

If we all show up for our tasks every day the Jamboree will be fun and easy!

General requirements for staff

- you must



- Be at least 18 years old by the time you arrive at the camp.
- Have completed the current swedish version of Safe from Harm course
 - You get a digital certificate when you have completed the course to show when you arrive to the camp.



- Be member of a scout organization affiliated with WOSM or WAGGGS
- Have presented a valid extract from the criminal records register (no older than 1 year), or an endorsement letter from your NSO.
- Follow Scouter's policies about alcohol, narcotics and tobacco.



- No alcohol or narcotics. Smoking only allowed in designated areas.

Communication during camp



- **Teams:** Our main source of communication between IST during Jamboree is Microsoft Teams. You will be assigned a Teams- account and get the information about how it will work before you arrive at the camp.
- **Phone:** To be able to work in Teams you need to bring a smart phone. Phones can be charged in the camp staff restaurant, the cafes and possibly at your workstation. A recommendation is to bring a powerbank, and a solar charger if you can.
- **Wi-fi:** is available at many places around the campsite but not everywhere.
- You will also be given information from your patrol leader on daily meetings.

When will I find out what my assignments are?

As a IST you will be given a place within one of the camp functions

Infra (infrastructure and safety),

Mat (food),

Program (scheduled activities),

Service och Kommunikation (information and service),

Spontan (open activities, cafes, restaurants, etc.)

We hope to be able to let you know which function you will be assigned to by the middle of June. This information will be communicated by email to the address you provided in your application.

To do before you arrive

1. Double check your application to see if the information is correct!
2. Take a extra look at what days you are going to be at the campsite so we can plan food and schedules
3. Check with your NSO so everything is approaved by them.
4. Complete the Swedish Safe From Harm and make sure you save the certificate saved at a place were you can easly find it at camp check-in



Plan your trip

If you fly to or in other ways arrive to Copenhagen or Malmö, then you do not need to pre book your trip to the campsite, but prepare by downloading the app for all regional public transport called "Skånetrafiken" where you can buy your tickets at the station before you start the last leg of the journey. You will need to register your phone number to use the app.

If you fly to or in other ways arrive in Stockholm or Gothenburg you need to pre book your journey to Kristianstad with SJ.se and for the busride the last part you can by with "Skånetrafiken" as explained above.

The bus stop is called "Norra Åsum Wendesgymnasiet".

Arrival at Norra Åsum

1. Check-in at assigned place.
2. You will get an onboarding and welcoming.
3. Put up your tent at the assigned place.
4. Meet up at the meeting point for your function/team and join the fun!

If you arrive on July 22, the first meal served will be dinner, 17:00 – 20:00.



If you arrive another day

- Camp staff check-in.

- The check-in will be open during the pre-camp (13-22 July) about the same time as the meal times. If the camp staff check-in is unattended when you arrive, there will be a phone number to call.
- After 25th July the camp staff check-in will move to Hjärtat ("The heart"), the camp site center. Follow instructions and signs on arrival.

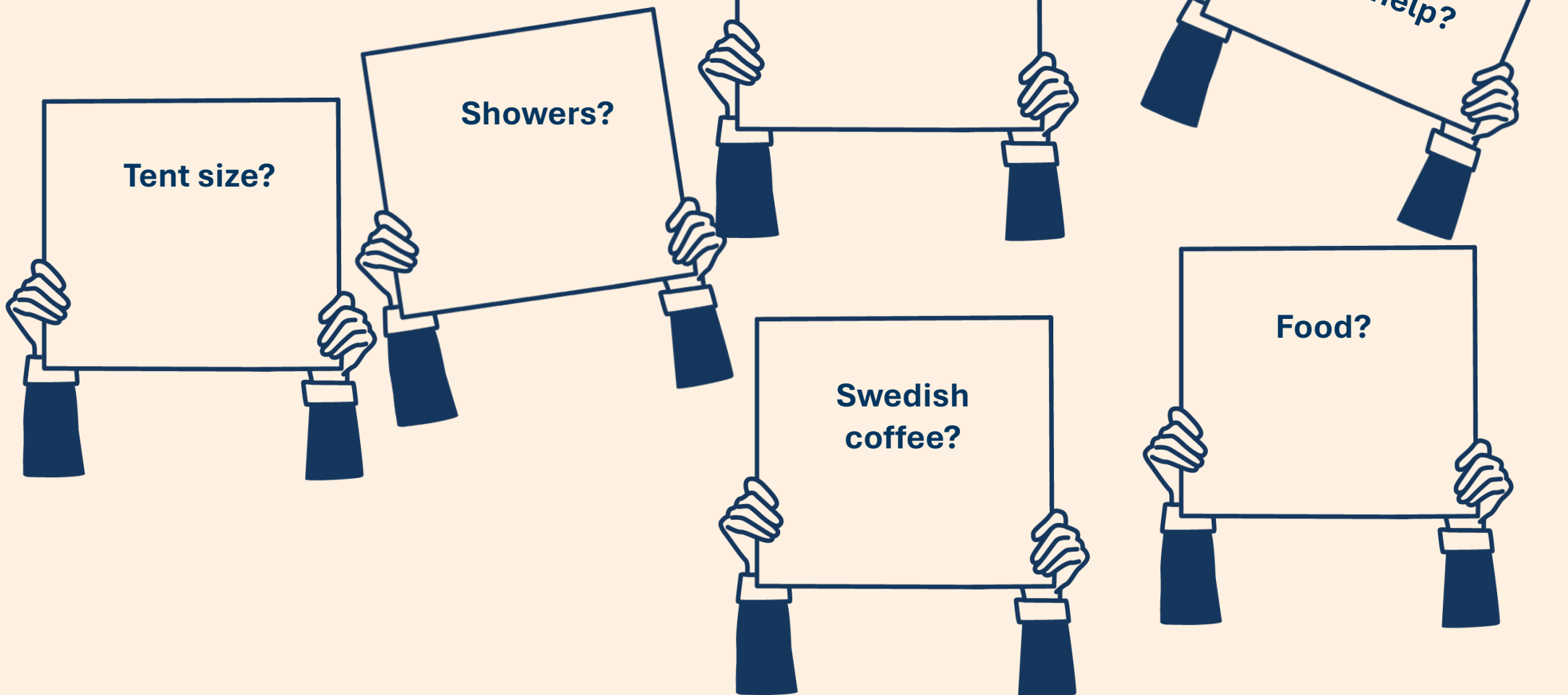
- Meet up with your function.

- During check-in you will get information about when and where a team leader will pick you up. Please raise your tent in the assigned area before starting to work.

Practical issues

The practical stuff



How do I prepare and what should I bring?



Get vaccinated against measles and Tick-Borne Encephalitis (TBE). In consultation with the regional medical services we recommend everyone coming to the camp site to be vaccinated against measles and TBE.



Bring a tent and your regular camp gear and equipment. If you need special clothing etc. for your allocation the Jamboree will make sure you have what you need.



Basic health care: First aid-kit, sunscreen, mosquito repellent, band aid, painkillers etc. The Jamboree will care for some health care in you need more help. You are responsible for your basic first aid and health care.

Staff camping space

1 person gets a 3x4 meter slot (suits a normal three person tent). Guy lines etc should fit within the slot.

2 people = 3x8 m or 6x4 m slot (If you are sharing tent you will get 2 slots together.)

3 people = same as 2 people

4 people = 6x8 m slot

You can sleep in a hammock if you bring a standing for it. There are no trees in the camp staff camping area.

Please note: The jamboree has no tents for lending. Plan together (tillsammans) with others from your country or contact swedish local groups.



Restaurang Himmel (The heavenly restaurant)

Camp staff have their own restaurant, called Himmel ("heaven" in Swedish). Here we are served breakfast, lunch and dinner. There will also be some snacks and lighter meals if you miss a meal time.

Utensils are provided for. Bring a water bottle and preferable something to grab a coffee/tea on the go in.

All meals in Restaurang Himmel are free for camp staff as long as you wear your staff scarf. Out in the camp site there are more locations to och grab a "fika" - as we call it in Swedish!



Swedish oddities

- Time is announced in 24 hrs (military time) - 9.00 is 9.00 am, 21.00 is 9.00 pm
- Show up on time for work – you are expected at the exact time
- All alcoholic beverages are forbidden at the whole camp site.
- Smoking is only allowed in designated areas
- Narcotics, including cannabis, is strictly forbidden in Sweden according to law
- Fika is a very important thing, do join us at all given times!
- Recycling is important and expected :)
